



What does the Data Breach Notification Act have to do with my business?

It's official: The New Mexico "Data Breach Notification Act" is in effect. If your business stores any data on customers this law applies to you.

Breach notification requirements are a dizzying patchwork of laws and regulations established on a state-by-state basis, and your business is almost certainly required to comply (even if you didn't know it). In this discussion, we try to provide some sense to the chaos, an understanding of what breach notification laws typically require, and provide some sound advice on how to handle the situation when resources are limited.
